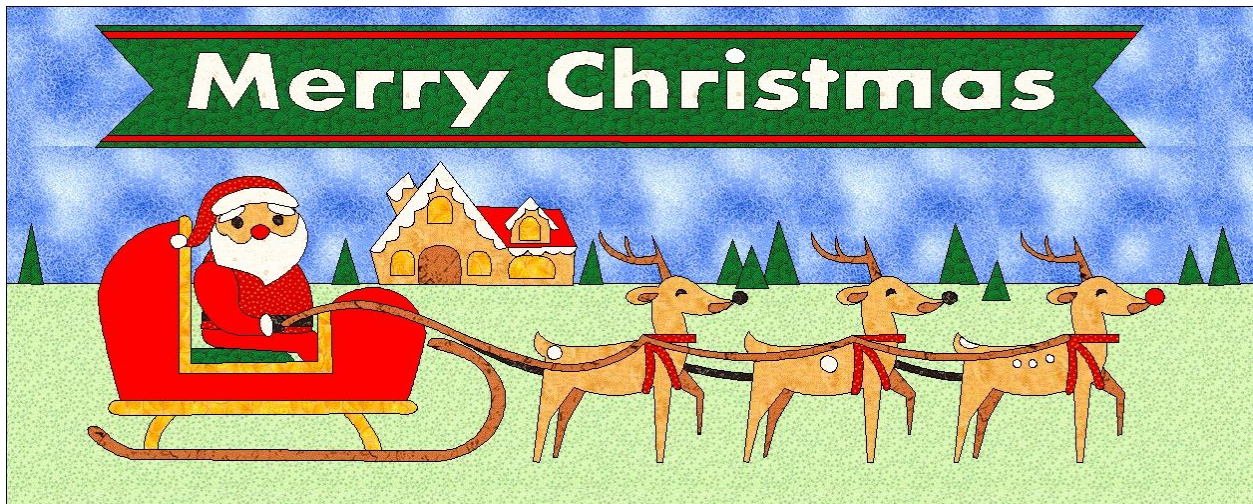




**“We wish you a Merry Christmas” row**

The pattern has been tested, but please feel free to email me if you see something wrong.

The row is 12.5 x 30.5 inches including seam allowance.

NB! Some pattern pieces are bigger than one page. Tape or glue along the glue edges before using them to trace your shapes on your fabric.

## Sewing order.

### Step 1

Sew Piece A+B (sky and snow) together.

### Step 2

Applique Santa's workshop and all the trees to the background.

### Step 3

Applique the banner pieces to the background above the cottage and trees.

### Step 4

Applique Santa with sleigh and reindeer to the background.

The pattern shapes provided is for raw edge applique.

Applique method.

There are various different applique methods you can use for this pattern;

- Hand applique
- Machine applique, straight, zig zag, any other special stitch you like (I have not included machine applique files)

### Quilting

You can use any quilting method and design on your quilt.












I love using a zig zag or machine blanket stitch to attach the pieces to the background while at the same time quilting the row to the batting and backing.

Finish your quilt off with a complimentary or contrasting binding.

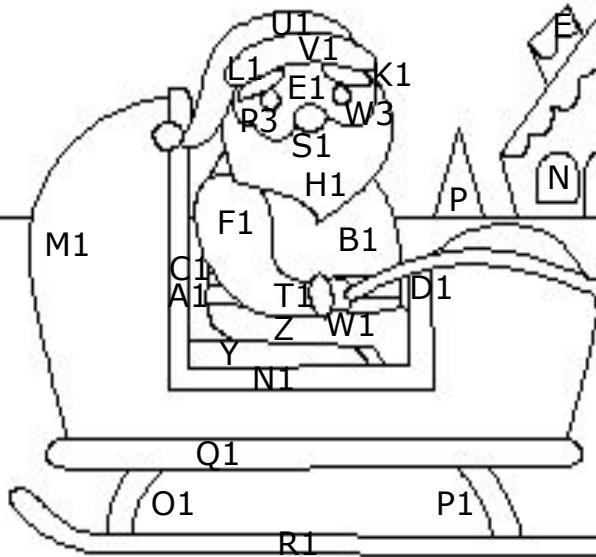

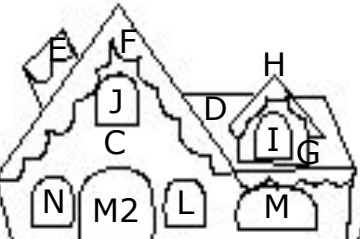

# Background piecing guide.

## Sky

Length 30 inches  
Width 6.70 inches, add a 1/4 inch for a seam allowance at the bottom

\*\*\*A suggestion to you, would be to cut the length and width slightly larger, as appliqueing your pieces to the background will shrink it a bit. You can trim it down later

## Snow covered ground

Length 30 inches  
Width 5.30, add a 1/4 inch for the seam allowance at the top.

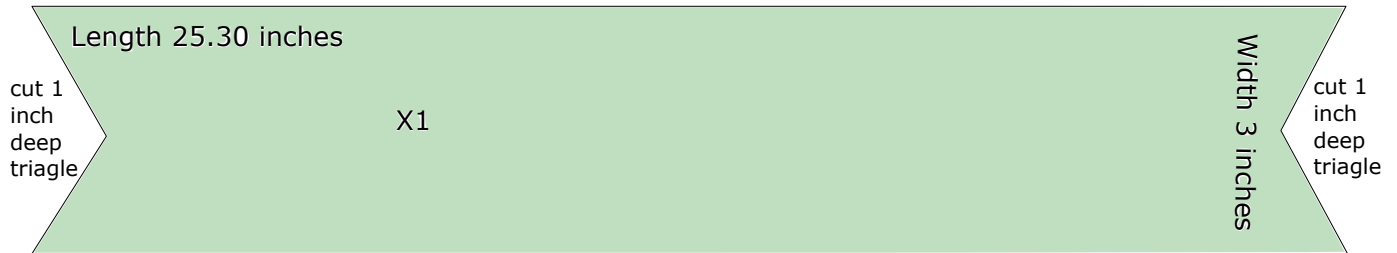

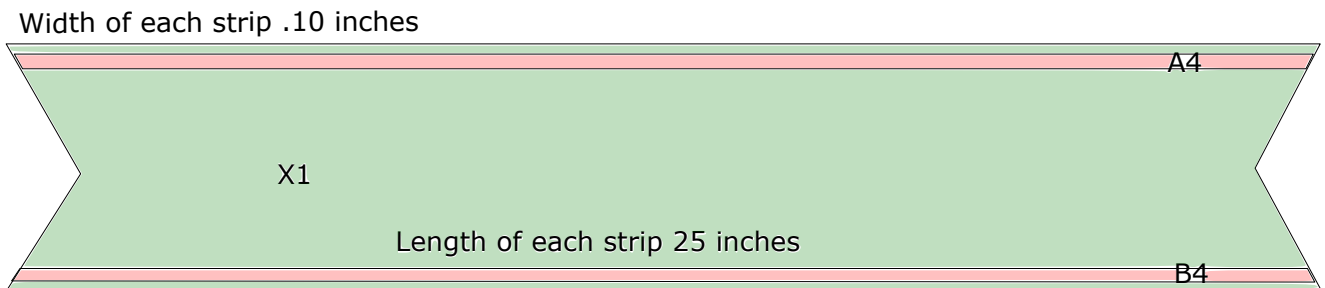


# Banner Layout Guide

Place main banner piece X1, .40 inches from the top edge of the sky and 2.10 inches from the left edge of the sky piece.



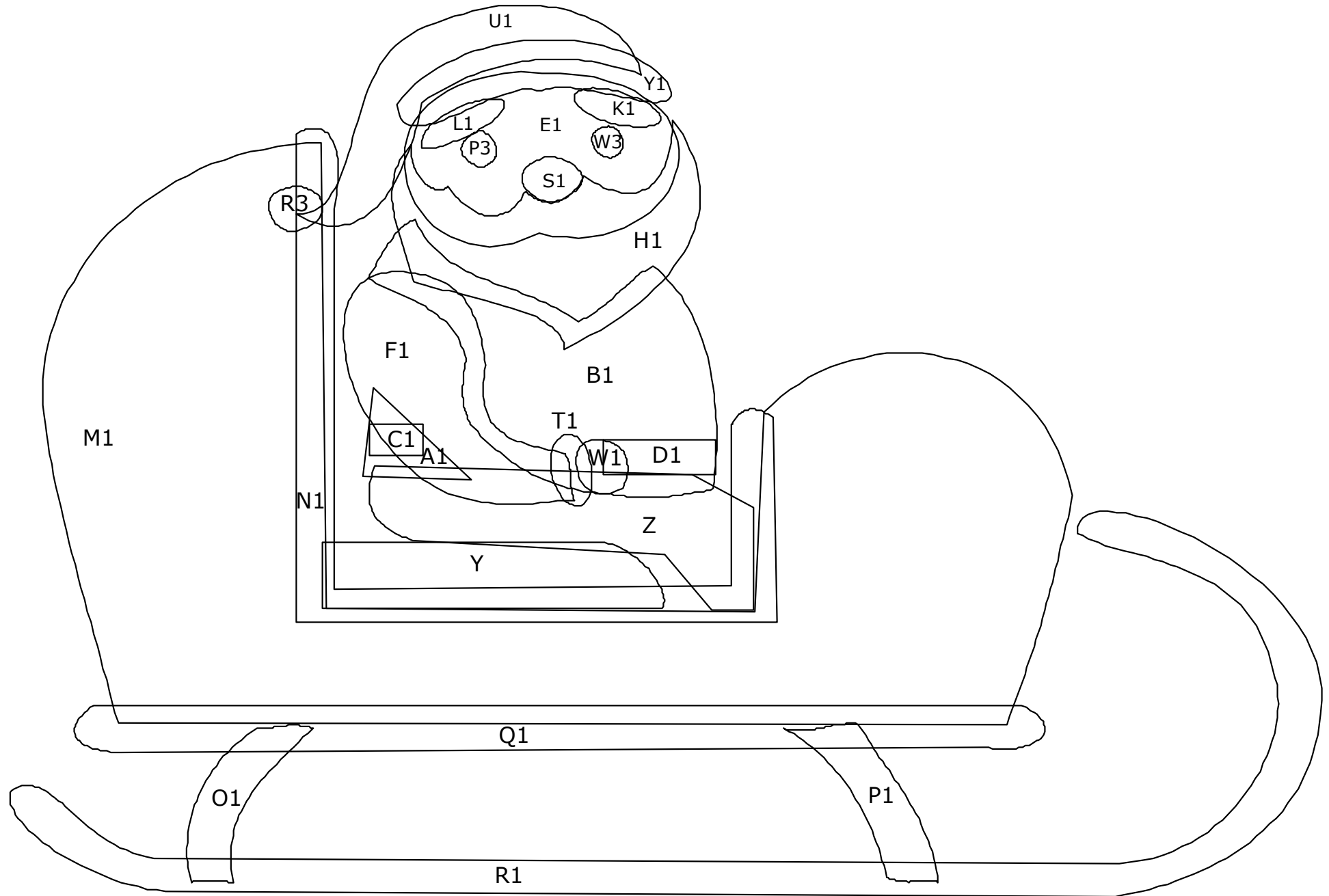
Place Piece A4 & B4 on top of Piece X1, about .10 inches from the top and bottom edge of the banner piece. Trip the edges of the 2 strips to fit in line with the banner.



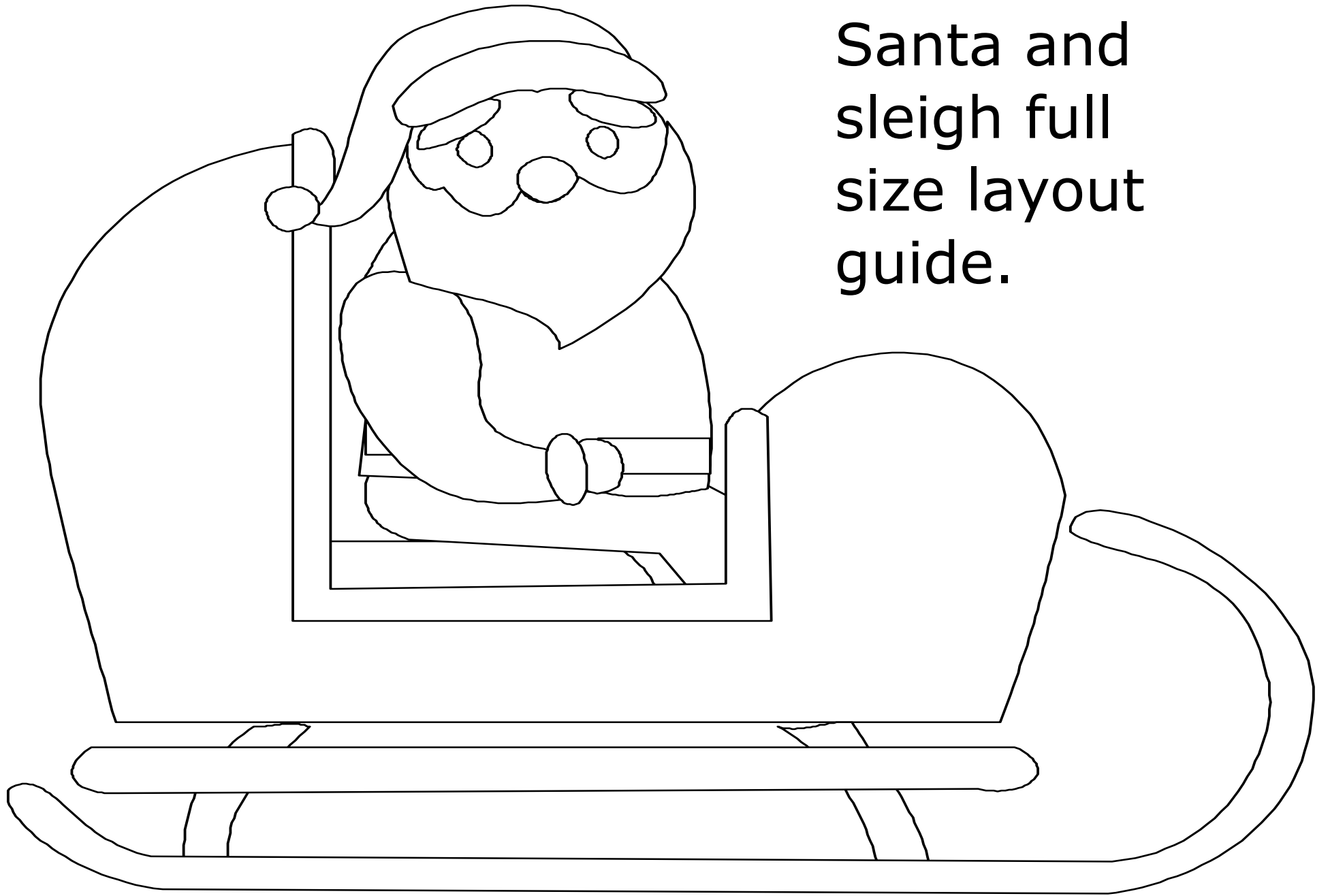
Add the Merry Christmas lettering last.

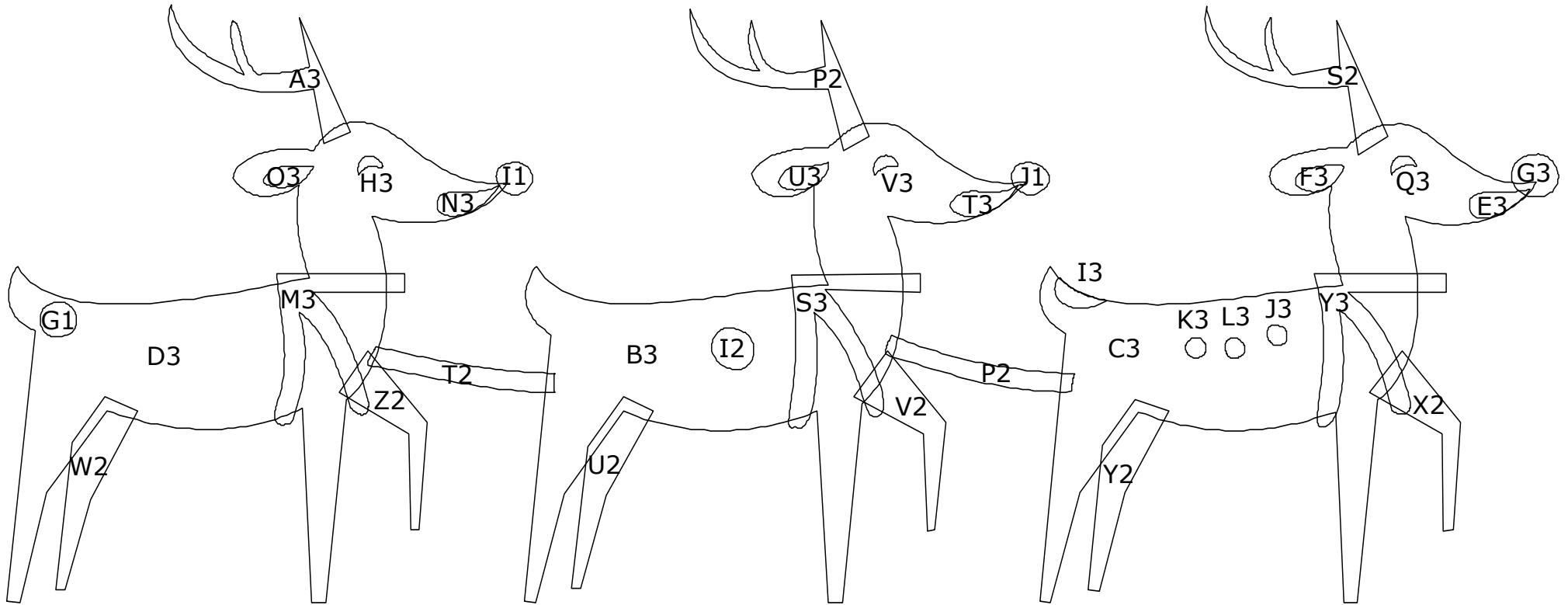

3 Reindeer to show placement, not to scale

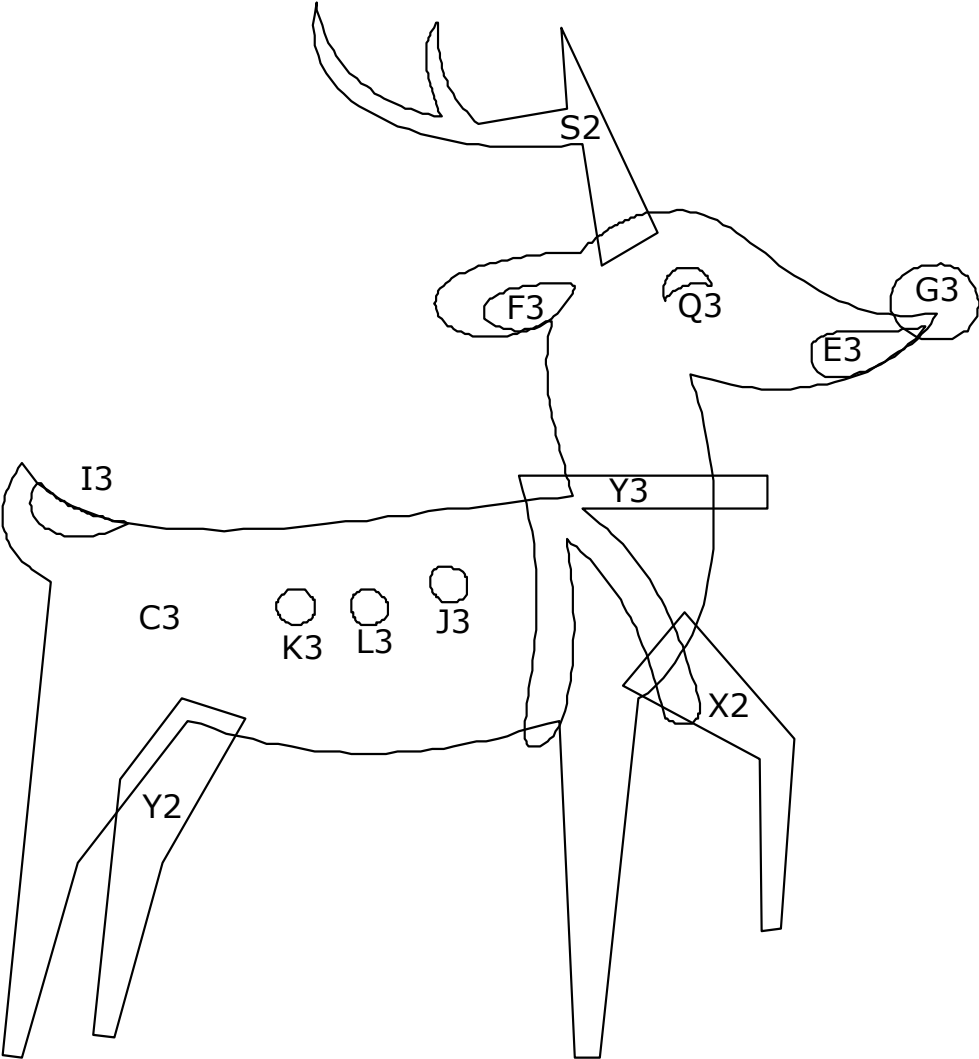

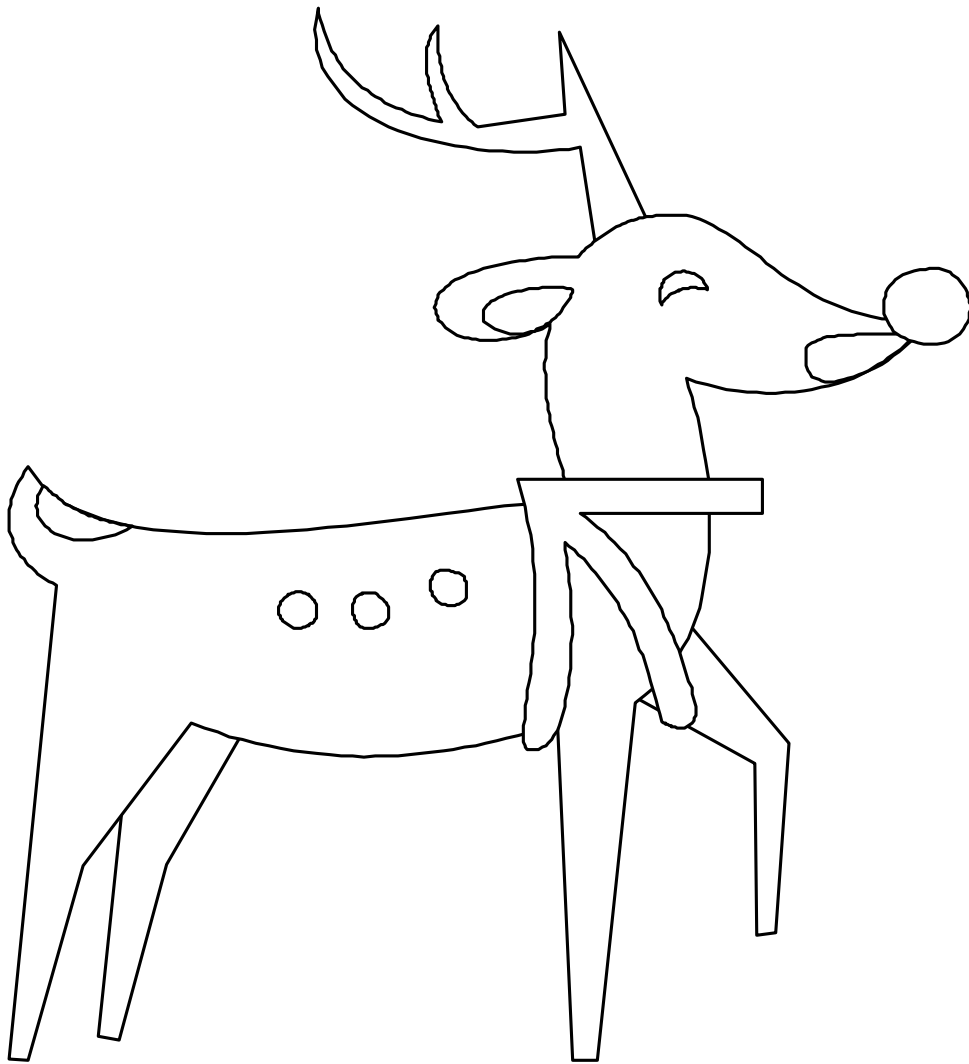
# Lead Reindeer, Rudolf! Layout Guide

With the reindeer, just finger press the pieces together, as you will need to layout all the reindeer in the correct places to add the sleigh reins behind them before heat pressing with an iron on the final layout.

## Santa, sleigh and reindeer placement.

To finalize the Santa, Sleigh and reindeer layout.

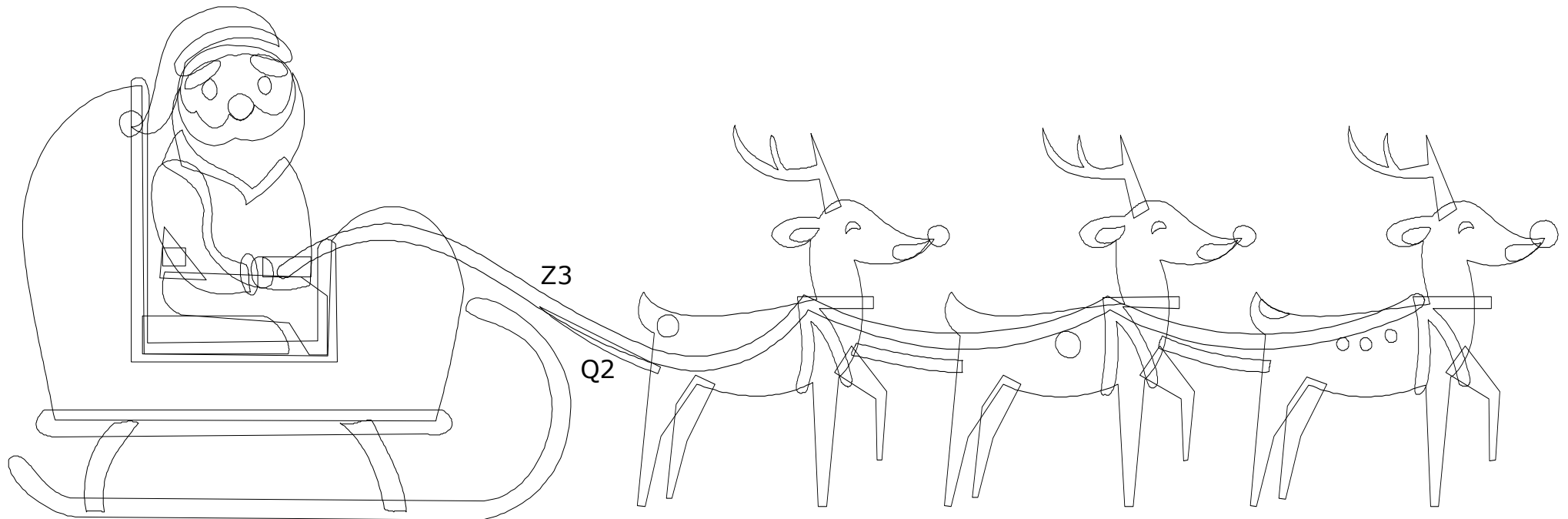
First layout your reindeer on the background, there should be about .80 inches space between the sleigh and the closest reindeer.

Piece Q2 needs to be eased in underneath the back of the reindeer.

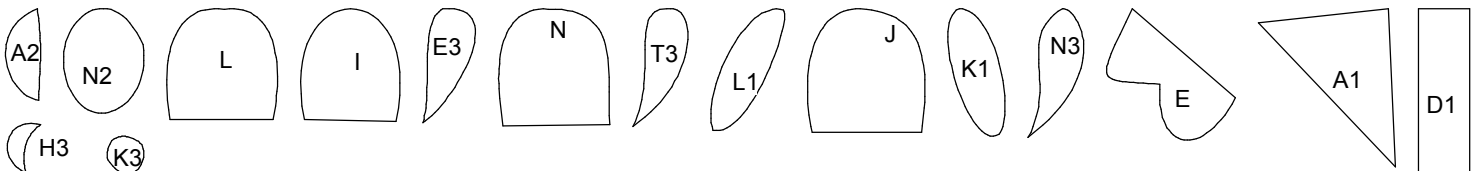
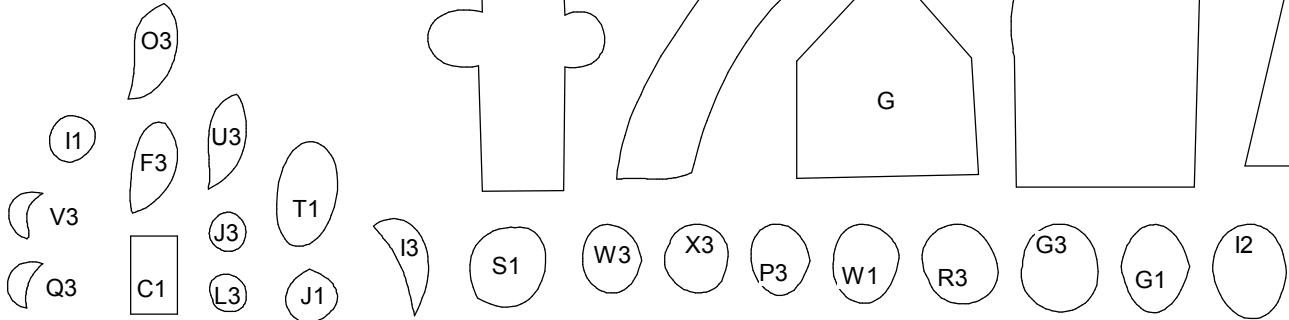
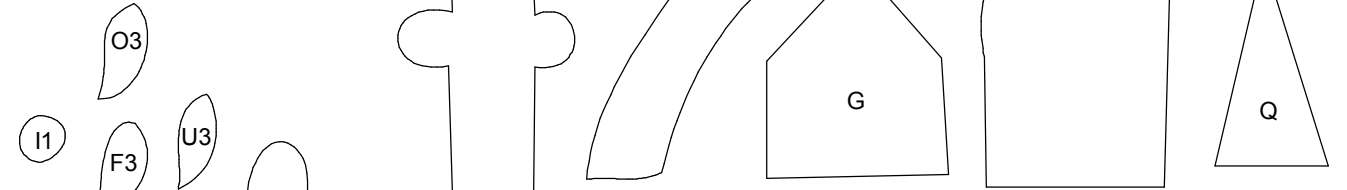
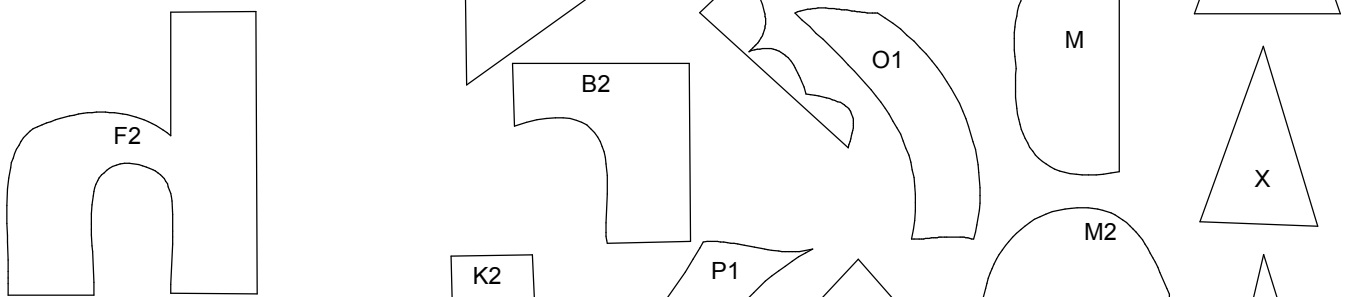
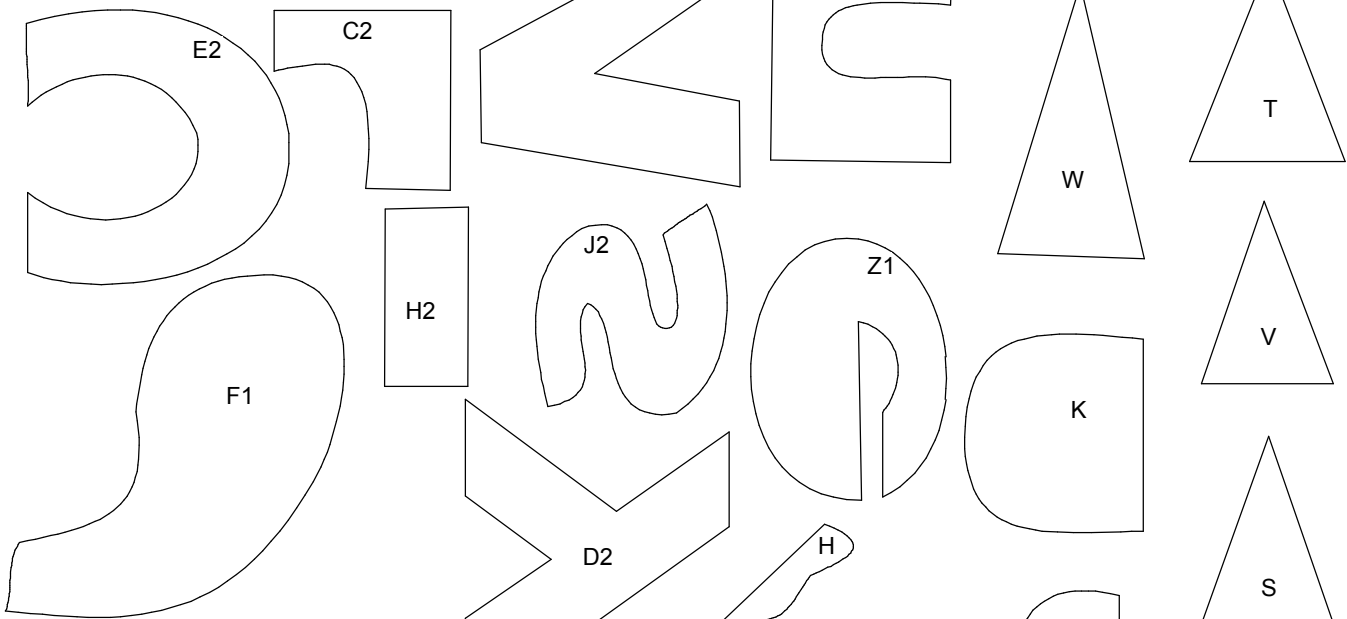
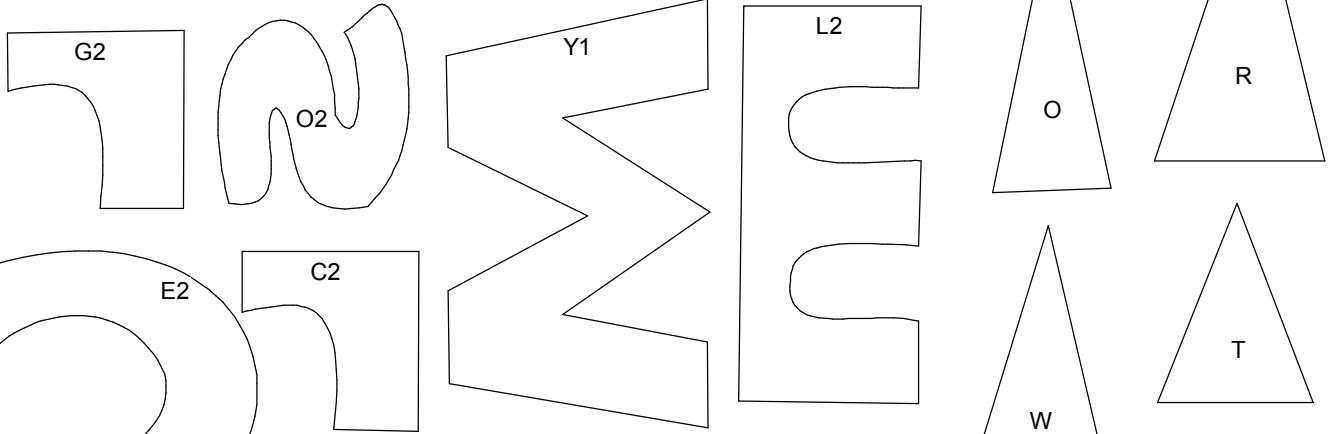
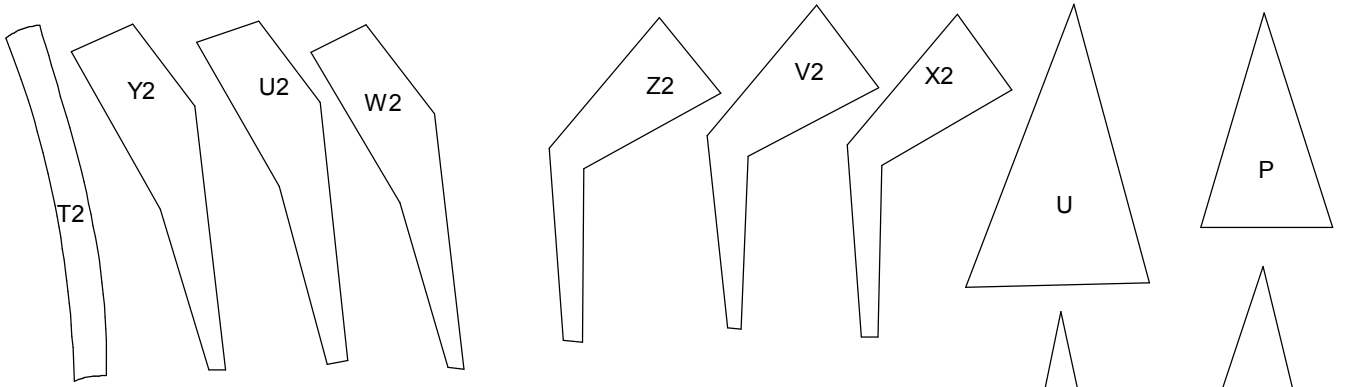
Before you heat press. Lay down the Z3 piece on top of the sleigh and the reindeer. The pointy bits needs to end up on the corner of the harnesses on the reindeer.

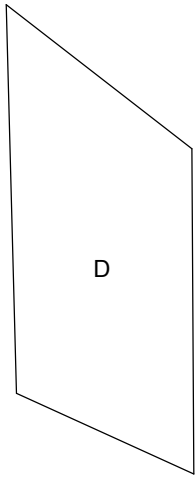
If not, just adjust the reindeer slightly to match up.

Heat press all of it now.



All that is left to place, is the trees in the background. See original layout at the beginning.  
Or you can place your trees wherever you like.

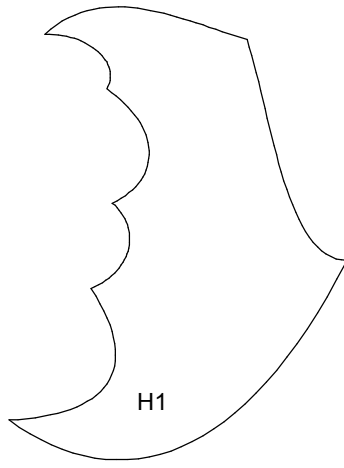




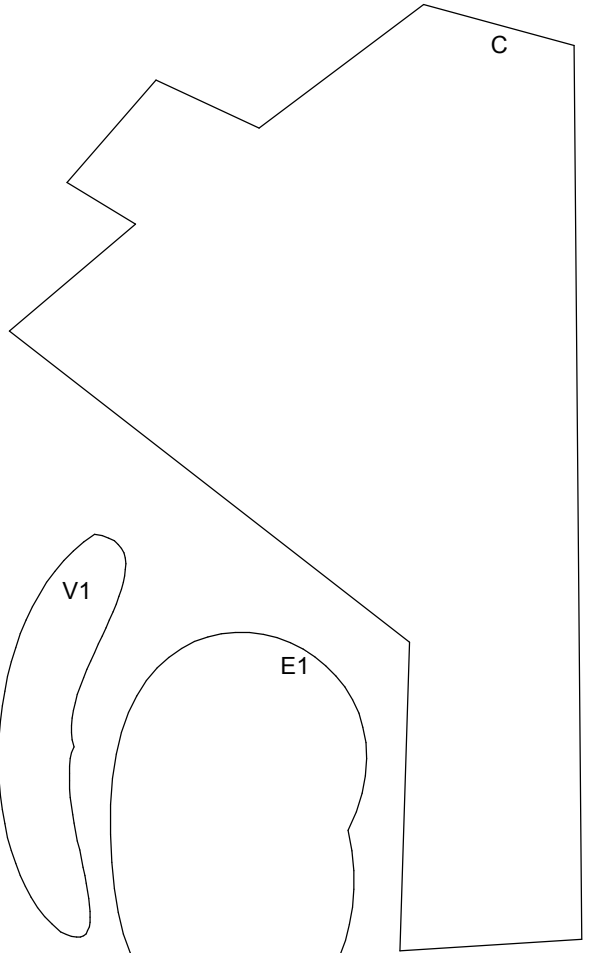

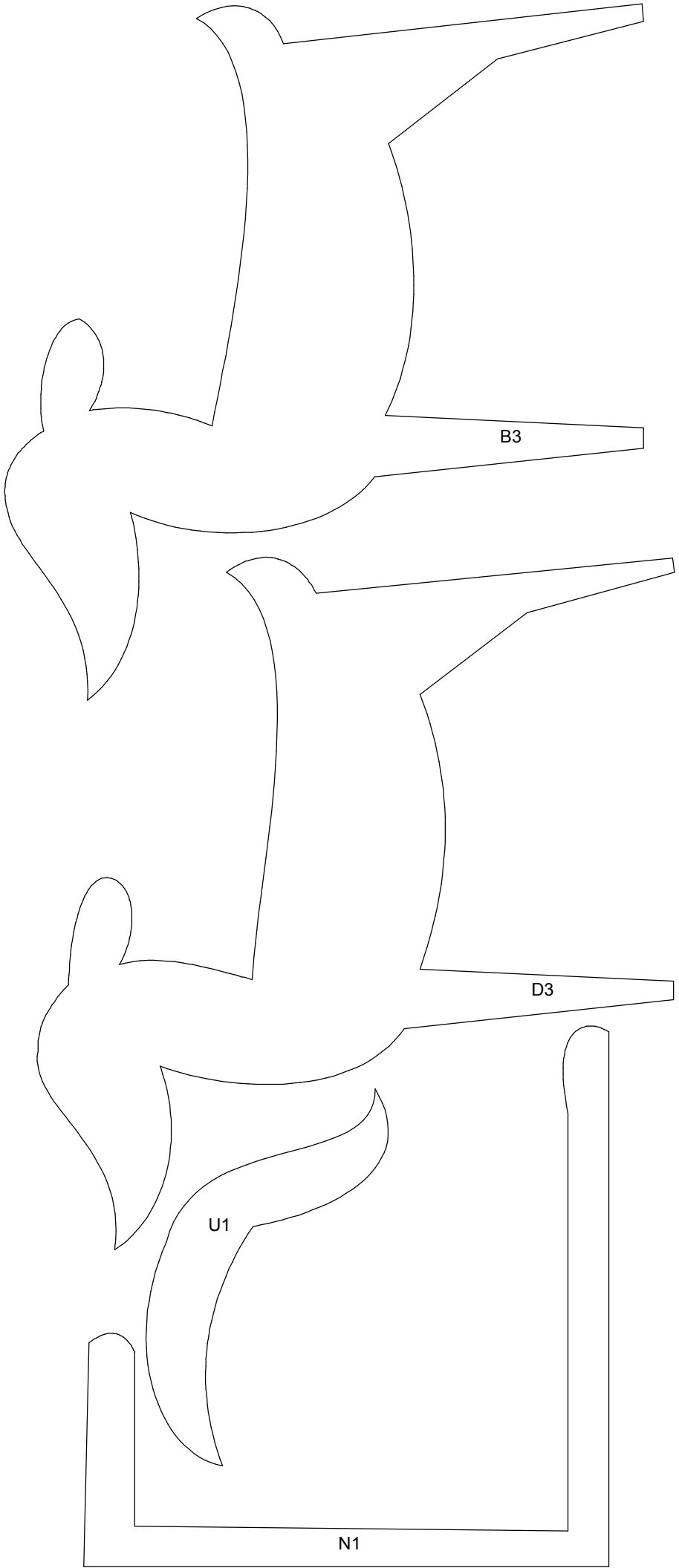




Front rein for deer
